3. To adopt new Articles of Association.

1. Any alteration made to this form of Proxy should be initialled.
2. In the case of joint holders the vote of the senior who tenders a vote, whether in person or by Proxy, will be accepted to the exclusion of the votes of the other joint holders. For this purpose seniority is determined by the order in which the names stand in the Register of Members of the Company.
3. In the case of a corporation this form should be under its common seal or the hand of an officer or attorney duly authorised in writing.
4. If it is desired to appoint as Proxy any person other than the chairman of the meeting, his name and address should be inserted in the blank space, reference to the chairman deleted and the alteration initialled. A Proxy need not be a member.
5. To direct the proxy how to vote on the resolutions mark the appropriate box with an 'X'. To abstain from voting on a resolution, select the relevant "Vote withheld" box. A vote withheld is not a vote in law, which means that the vote will not be counted in the calculation of votes for or against the resolution. If no voting indication is given, the proxy will vote or abstain from voting at his or her discretion. The proxy will vote (or abstain from voting) as he or she thinks fit in relation to any other matter which is put before the meeting.
6. A member is entitled to appoint more than one proxy, provided that each proxy is appointed to exercise the rights attached to different shares. If the number of shares for whom a proxy is appointed is not completed above, the appointment will be deemed to relate to all shares held by the appointor, and if multiple such appointments are received, the earliest will be accepted as valid.
